

The following items are required to open a business account.

Sole Proprietorship (DBA - Doing Business As)

- Social Security Number (SSN) or IRS EIN - Employer Identification Number Form
- Names of all authorized signers
- Copy of a Certificate of Assumed Name (DBA) with the county clerk's office where the business is located.

Partnership

- IRS EIN - Employer Identification Number Form
- Partnership Agreement including the names of all owners (*if applicable*)
- Names of all authorized signers
- Articles of Organization or Secretary of State registration

Limited Liability Company (LLC)

- IRS EIN - Employer Identification Number Form or Social Security Number (SSN) for an LLC with only one owner
- LLC Operating Agreement including the names of all owners (if applicable)
- Names of all authorized signers
- Articles of Organization or Secretary of State registration

Corporation

- IRS EIN - Employer Identification Number Form
- Certificate of Incorporation or Secretary of State registration
- Corporate Resolution listing authorized signers if officer's names are not included on Articles of Incorporation or New York Secretary of State registration or other authorized signers are to be on the account

Clubs, Associations, Organizations

- IRS EIN - Employer Identification Number Form
- Certificate of Incorporation or Secretary of State registration
- Articles of Organization or Secretary of State registration

Ownership

You will be required to provide the name, address, date of birth, SSN and a copy of a valid Government issued ID for the following individuals:

- Each individual who owns 25% or more of the business.
- The individual who has a significant responsibility in managing the business.

Authorized Signers

An authorized signer is any individual who is authorized to sign on behalf of the business. Authorized signers will need to provide their name, address, social security number, date of birth, and valid Government issued ID. Each authorized signer must sign the documentation at account opening.
